Angela Takes on Third Sponsored Abseil

Congratulations to Angela on completing her **third sponsored abseil** in as many years!

Angela has once again taken on a daring challenge, this time to **raise money for Coleridge Ward at Musgrove Park Hospital, Taunton, in memory of her late husband, Michael.**

On her fundraising page, Angela explains that she wants to **thank the doctors and nurses who cared for Michael in the final hours of his life**, treating him with "respect and professionalism" and showing great compassion to them both.

The funds raised will go to **Love Musgrove, the official charity of Musgrove Park Hospital**, helping to improve services, provide equipment and support patients and their families.

Having previously completed the Big Bristol Abseil from Bristol Children's Hospital in 2024 and an abseil from the top of St Michael's Hospital in 2025, Angela has now completed her third consecutive annual abseil challenge.

Thanks to the generosity of her supporters, she has already **raised more than £700** and **would like to thank everyone who has sponsored and encouraged her.**

Friends of St Andrew's, Congresbury – We Need Your Support

Many of you will have noticed the condition of the **Refectory** as you walk through Congresbury churchyard. The Friends of St Andrew's are planning **urgent repairs and external redecoration** of this much-loved historic building - and we need your help.

The Refectory, dating from around **1446**, is a **Grade I listed building**, so specialist work is required and can only be carried out at certain times of year. The cost of this project is estimated at **£10,000.**

Over the past two years, the Friends have already spent around **£15,000** on essential works, including the church clock, lighting, and a stained glass window. These efforts help preserve **St Andrew's Church (consecrated in 1215)** for future generations.

As a community, we are all custodians of this heritage. We want to avoid seeing these buildings fall into disrepair at the heart of our village.
