Lectionary Reading: Matthew 5:1-12

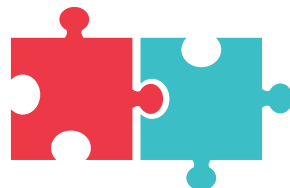


Tuesday 9th June

Lectionary Reading: Job 29:11-16

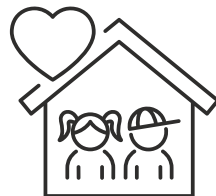


Friday 12th June

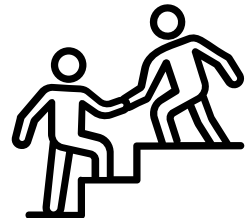

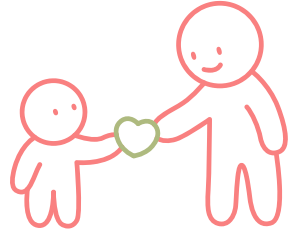


Sunday 28th June

Lectionary Reading: Matthew 10:40-end

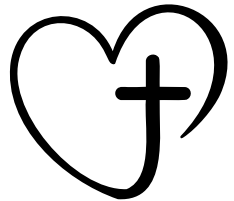


Monday 29th June
